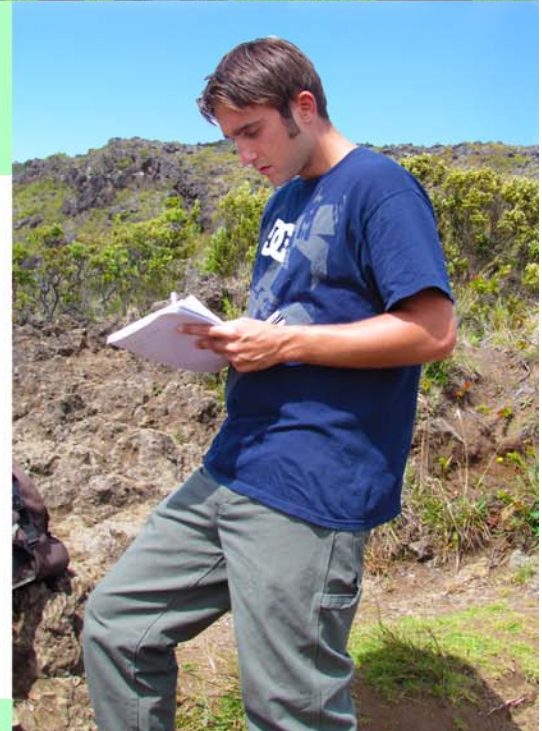




## A Spring Break Internship for Middle School Students at Haleakalā National Park

Have you ever wanted to be a park ranger? Do you want to help protect Hawai'i's endangered species? Does the idea of a job in conservation or resource management get you excited? Come join us at Haleakalā National Park for the Kupukupu 'Āina Internship Program. This week long paid internship was designed to provide local youth with a chance to learn about the career opportunities in the National Park System and to help protect natural, historical, and cultural resources. The interns will work alongside park professionals in various programs, including Resources Management, Interpretation, and Facilities Management. Application deadline is January 31st, 2012.



### Applicants must be:

- A Hawai'i State Resident
- A current Middle School Student (Grade 6-8)
- Available and willing to work full time between March 12 - 16, 2012 (7:30 am - 4:00 pm plus travel time)
- Able to obtain transportation to and from War Memorial Stadium in Kahului or Eddie Tam Gym in Makawao (free transportation from there to the park)
- Able and willing to work outdoors at elevations ranging from sea level to 10,000 feet in varying weather conditions
